COVID Update

As with the rest of the country and other schools, we are seeing the impact of COVID increase within our community. We currently have 14 confirmed cases of COVID, and approximately one quarter of our school absent due to COVID circumstances. Again, we cannot say this enough - a MASSIVE thanks to all our whānau who inform us so quickly of their situation. What we have also noticed is the huge amount of aroha and support that has come in from our whānau, wishing each other well and for speedy recoveries. This reflects the wairua of our kura and the awhi we all have for each other. We have started feeling the impact on our staff, where some of our children are having to be split across other classes. Should the impact to our staff begin to affect the delivery of regular onsite teaching and learning, we may consider moving to a hybrid model of distance learning and onsite. This could be that some children learn from home and some learn from school. This would be communicated to you in full **before** this occurred.

Despite COVID, our tamariki continue to be immersed in rich and creative learning experiences. One of our key focuses this year is the development of effective Play Based Learning. All our akomanga have been implementing and trialling a variety of provocations and ideas to support Play in the classroom.
