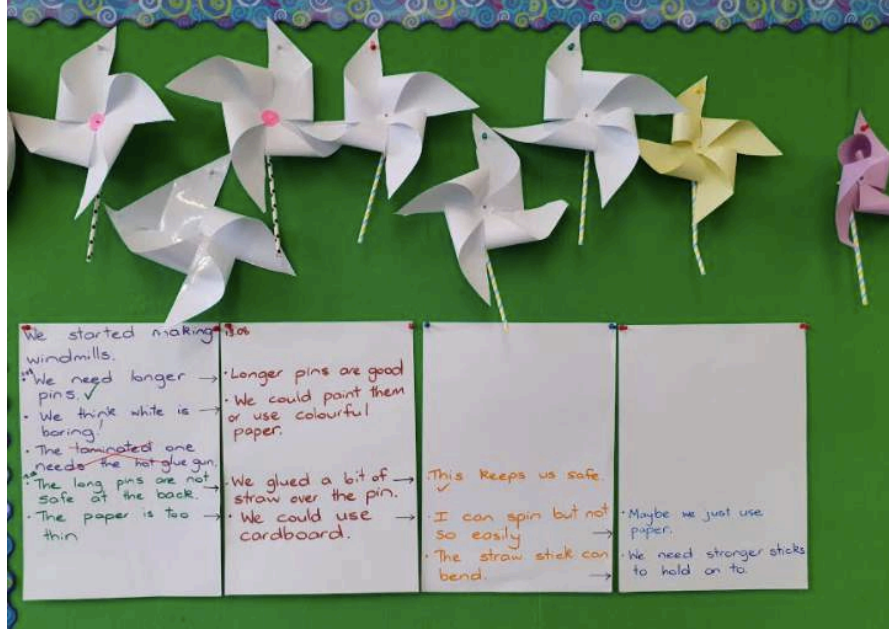

Alert Level 2

As you know, the majority of Aotearoa including us, remains at Alert Level 2. We greatly value your support and understanding with our Alert Level 2 measures as we play our role in keeping our community safe. While we are at Alert Level 2, a few reminders of some of the measures:

- If your child displays cold/flu like symptoms, such as, runny nose, coughing, sneezing and/or a temperature - **PLEASE** keep them at home. Outside of the precautionary measures for COVID, these are also symptoms that are reflective of a cold or flu, which means your child is unwell and should not be at school. Likewise, if your child shows these symptoms at school, we will call you for you to come and collect your child. The cold/flu season is hitting us later this year and we are noticing the impact of this now.
- Hand washing with soap and water remains one of the best preventative measures. Hand washing should be for at least 20 seconds with soap and warm water.
- Advice from the Ministry of Education is that it is not a requirement at Alert Level 2 for children and staff to wear face masks at school.
- Should you need to come into school to collect your child, we will need to add you to our Contact Tracing Register. We also have the COVID-19 Contact Tracing QR code on entry to the office and hall.
